**BORN:** December 26, 1754 Anne Arundel County, Maryland (a) (d)

**SON OF:** Thomas Iams & Elizabeth Hill (d)

**DIED:** June 24, 1834 (b)

**AGE:** 80 (f)

**BURIED:** Dutch Cemetery, Row, 8 Grave 13, Richland Township, Belmont County, Ohio. (c)

**MARKER:** Original and Military

**MARRIED:** November 24, 1785 Washington, Pennsylvania (d)

**SERVICE IN REVOLUTION:**

**General:** Maryland Line

**Specific:** Soldier was pensioned. Applied March 10, 1834 in Belmont County, Ohio. Ref. S8751.

**RESIDED:** Soldier lived in Anne Arundel County at enlistment and lived there until 1794 when he moved to Washington County, Pennsylvania. In 1833 he moved to Belmont County, Ohio.

**WIFE:** Catherine Hampton (b)

**BORN:** ca 1766 (h)

**DIED:** May 12, 1838 age 72 (g)

**BURIED:** Dutch Cemetery, Richland Township, Belmont County, Ohio
